directory.

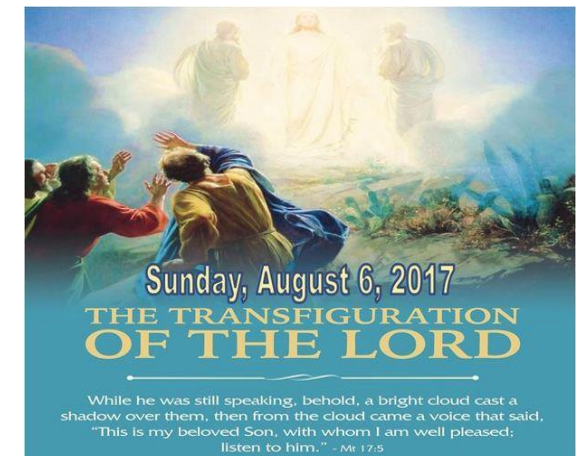
NORTH IDAHO CURSILLO REPORT: On Saturday, June  
3rd a group of Cursillistas from Moscow, Lewiston,  
and Lapwai met for an all-day workshop with four  
Region XII leaders. Beginning and ending with  
prayer, there were talks given on Charisms in the  
Relationship to Cursillo, History of Cursillo,  
Essence/Mentality/Purpose of Cursillo, and Method  
for Restarting Cursillo. Lively discussion followed  
each talk and 16 of those present signed up to form a  
core group of leaders. We invite others from  
the Canadian border to Grangeville to join us as we  
move forward in revitalizing the Cursillo movement  
in north Idaho. Action items include formulating an  
apostolic plan for Diocesan approval, cultivating a  
School of Leaders, and organizing Pre-  
Cursillo/Cursillo/Post-Cursillo activities. Steps ahead  
include continuing with Ultreya gatherings (currently  
alternating between Moscow and Lewiston on the  
second Friday of each month (from 6:30 to 8:00 pm)).  
We are planning on another regional workshop this
