- 1 Consecrate your family to the Holy Family.
- 2 Pray the Family Rosary together.
- 3 Strengthen and/or affirm your family's devotion to the Eucharist as the nourishment of family life.

Purpose to keep the Sabbath holy together, and not let worldly distractions or secular obligations get in the way.

Remind everyone of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist as you drive to

church together. Pope John Paul II wrote, "In the eucharistic gift of charity the Christian family finds the foundation and soul of its communion and its mission.

- 4 Place an icon or image of the Holy Family on your table.
- 5 Strengthen your family bonds through shared joy.
- 6 Create a "Family Feast Day."

You can base it on a devotion to a saint, or the patron saint of your wedding day and/or the day you moved into or blessed your new home. Your home is the domestic church for your family, and a beating heart of sorrows and joys where you all dwell and grow.

- 7 Share stories of beloved family members.
- 8 Together, with your family, write a short prayer you can say following Grace before meals.
- 9 Have a holy water font at the door. Bless yourselves and each other as you leave and return.
- 10 Bless each other at bedtime and mention each family member's name in prayer before falling asleep.

As we end each day, let us recall these words of Pope St. John Paul II: "The family, more than any other human reality, is the place in which the person is loved for himself and in which he learns to live the sincere gift of self." God bless your family.
